Hot-shooting Bishop Heelan ends Glenwood's third straight trip to Des Moines

It's often said records, stats and tendencies can be thrown out at the Iowa State Basketball Tournament.

It's a whole new ballgame in Des Moines. Just ask Bishop Heelan.

The Crusaders, who entered shooting less than 30 percent from behind the arc this season, connected on 11-of-16 three pointers – 68 percent – against Glenwood in the Class 4A semifinals Thursday. They used that hot hand to key a 15-4 second quarter run that allowed them to pull away in a 68-51 win over the Rams Thursday night at Wells Fargo Arena.

"It was super frustrating," said Glenwood coach Brian Rasmussen of the Crusaders' night from behind the arc. "We started in zone and went man to man, we switched, and we didn't switch. We tried to throw some different defensive looks at them and they knocked shots down. They flat out couldn't miss. That's how it felt."

That hot shooting started in the second quarter. After taking a slim 12-11 lead after the first quarter, Heelan hit all six of their threes in second frame and took a 38-25 lead into halftime.

When the Rams did get stops on defense, they had offensive struggles of their own. Leading scorers Madison Camden and Jenna Hopp – who entered averaging better than 19 points and 17 points each, respectively – were held to a combined six first half points.

Abby Hughes, the Rams' third leading scorer this season, hit 3-of-5 three's and led the way with 12 first half points. But in the third quarter, when Glenwood needed their top scorers to chip away at the Crusaders' lead,

Camden, Hopp and Hughes all went scoreless.

And Heelan took advantage. The lead swelled to as many as 19 in the third quarter.

"It's tough to come back like that," Rasmussen said. "Those are big time players that typically make big time plays for us. We had opportunities and we had chances and Heelan was really good. I don't want to take that away from how we played because I thought

our girls were doing the right things, trying to make plays and they (Heelan) were very disruptive to what we wanted to do."

Heelan played an aggressive, match-up 2-3 zone that forced the Ram wings off their spots and harassed the passing lanes. The Crusaders forced 17 turnovers, grabbed 12 steals and limited to Glenwood to 40 percent shooting on the night.

Heelan coach Darrin Koolstra said after the game he was willing to concede Hopp would get her points, but their goal was to not let Camden heat up.

"The key for us was keeping Camden from knocking down consecutive threes, as she can do," Koolstra said. "We talked on the defensive end about knowing where she was all night. We wanted to take her shot away and we did that until the fourth quarter when she got free for a couple."

Camden was 0-of-6 from the field through three quarters and did not score until five minutes remained in the game. She finished with a season-low nine points on 3-of-9 shooting.

The Rams never got closer than 13 points in the second half.

Hughes led Glenwood with 16 points. Hopp added 11 points and Brynlee Arnold chipped in five points and 11 rebounds.

Jada Newberg and Lauryn Peck scored 17 points each to lead four Crusaders in double figures. Brooklyn Stanley scored 16 and Kenley Meis 13. Heelan (23-3) fell 54-40 to Cedar Rapids Xavier (20-6) in Saturday's Class 4A finals.

The Rams close their season with a record of 20-5. In all, seven seniors suited up for the last time in a historic run for Glenwood. The group compiled a record of 84-15, won three Hawkeye 10 Conference titles and qualified for three state tournament appearances in their four years.

Rasmussen said the semifinal loss, the Rams' second in three years after falling in last year's state finals, "flat out stinks" for his seniors.

"There's no doubt in our minds that we wanted to have the opportunity to play on

Camden, Hopp earn All-Hawkeye 10 honors

Glenwood's two leading scorers this season were tabbed as unanimous first team All-Hawkeye 10 Conference basketball selections for the 2021-2022 season.

Madison Camden, a senior, and Jenna Hopp, a junior, were named to the first team by every league coach along with Creston junior Doryn Paup. Paul led the conference in scoring with an 18.8 average.

The Rams' duo helped Glenwood to its third straight Hawkeye 10 Conference title and to the Class 4A state semifinals this season.

Camden led the Rams in scoring and was second in the conference at 18.6 points per game. She also led the conference with 59 three-pointers. Hopp averaged 16.9 points, 6.6 rebounds and 4.2 assists per game.

Glenwood seniors Abby Hughes and Brynlee Arnold both earned second team nods. Hughes averaged 10.4 points and stepped up her scoring to 16.5 points per game while earning a spot on the Class 4A All-State Tournament team last weekend.

Arnold scored nine points while pulling

down 8.2 rebounds and blocking 1.7 shots per game.

Saturday (in the championship game). We wanted to bring it home and that wasn't in the cards tonight. A lot of that was Heelan and the way they played tonight.

"But these seniors, three years in a row being here and then a district final in their freshman year, it's a new game in Glenwood for Glenwood girls basketball. It's been an awesome four years and we want to keep it going."

Glenwood didn't get off to the start they wanted but they closed the opening half exactly the way they wanted.

Trailing 19-13 after a bumpy first quarter in the quarterfinals at the Iowa State Girls Basketball tournament, the Rams closed the half on a 20-3 run to take a 35-27 lead into intermission.

That lead would grow to as many as 17 in the second half as the Rams held off a furious late Bluejay rally in a 64-59 victory Tuesday at Wells Fargo Arena.

Bondurant-Farrar never made it easy for the Rams. They led by as many as eight points in the first quarter as Glenwood struggled to adjust to the Bluejays' post-heavy offense and a 2-3 zone that often morphed into a sticky 1-3-1 zone.

"They came in focused and ready to go and gave us a big punch early and the girls stayed the course and stuck with the game plan," said Glenwood coach Brian Rasmussen. "We made some tweaks and were able to turn the tables. They certainly didn't go down without a fight because that quarter, they gave us everything they had to fight back in it."

The biggest tweak for the Rams was on the defensive end. After opening the game in man-to-man, they switched to a 2-3 zone of their to open the second quarter, clogging the interior passing lanes for the Bluejays post players.

"We disguised our zone a little bit," Rasmussen said. "It was more effective than our transition man (defense) that we were playing early."

Glenwood also heated up offensively. The Rams made 8-of-12 shots in the second quarter, including a trio of three-pointers.

Jenna Hopp, who had a team-high 12 points in the first half, helped key the Rams' second quarter run. Her three-pointer at the halftime buzzer capped a 22-8 second quarter.

The Rams second half would not shrink below double-digits until five minutes remained in the game. With 6-foot-3 center Brynlee Arnold on the bench with a fourth personal foul, the Bluejays' post-players went to work.

All-state center Katelyn Lappe scored six points in a 13-0 Bondurant-Farrar run that trimmed the Rams' lead to 59-56 with 1:45 to go.

Madison Camden's two free throws for the Rams pushed the lead to 61-56 and a Hopp steal led to a Abby Hughes put back to make it 64-56 with 36 seconds to go.

The Bluejays would hit a three with less than a second left but it was too little too late.

Despite the momentum flip and the big stakes, Rasmussen never lost confidence in his team.

"These are 16- and 17-year-old kids playing on a big stage but we do have some experience playing here and we had enough poise at the end to take care of the ball and finish," Rasmussen said. "We hit some big free throws. We slowed it down a bit but we tried to stay in attack mode. We knew there wasn't any way they wouldn't go down without a fight."

Hopp and Camden each scored 18 points to lead the Rams and Hughes added 17. All three played every minute of the win.

That wasn't by design, Rasmussen said.

"I gave them opportunities to come out but they politely declined," Rasmussen said of his three leading scorers. "I think one of our strengths in this game for us was that we could keep our pressure up, keep our transition going and make it a track meet. They are well equipped to play 32 minutes."

Lappe, a Northern Iowa softball recruit, scored a game-high 19 points but she didn't get her first points on the night until just 18 seconds remained in the first half. Time and again the quicker Rams cutoff passing lanes and made the 6-foot-1 Lappe have to work for every touch.

"We were excited with how we handled her the first half," Rasmussen said. "A lot of our focus and defensive prep was to not let her touch the ball and if she did it wasn't going to be in the paint and I thought we did a good job of that. She's a competitor and she got her points but she had to make some great catches to do it."

The Bluejays close their season with a record of 17-7.
